ATHENS, GREECE

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Topics and suggestions below will introduce students to modern Greek culture that form the foundations of Modern Greek identity. The course usually includes an introduction to elementary modern Greek language and participation in a series of lectures and cultural events (tastings, guided tours) integrated into this course. Activities take place once (max twice per week) and some of them require a bus transfer.

Katerina Zafeiri, the Athens Centre Cultural and Learning Coordinator, is organizing the activities and accompanying the group for most of the visits to ensure smooth execution.
